

## **Dulux SA adds** colour to Tafelsig

Walking around Tafelsig, a previously disadvantaged suburb in Mitchell's Plain, Cape Town, the challenges of the neighbourhood are clear. Walls are littered with graffiti. Public spaces including parks are run down rendering the parks and public spaces unsafe. A few members of the community had an idea to fix this.

Spearheaded by Michael Bell, a community placemaker with experience in Urban Art, the idea to upgrade the parks and add colour to public spaces was born.

"With Covid19 on the rise, the need for safe public spaces where community members can stretch their legs, read a book or children can play became a necessity. We knew that it was the right time for change and started working immediately. We knew that community engagement and buy in was of utmost importance and we set ahead to get that first," said Bell.

Dulux came on board to sponsor paint to upgrade the public space. As Bell's team transformed the public facades, the community called on Bell and Dulux to expand the project beyond the public spaces to include the street facings of an additional 120 houses. In the end, 1000 liters of Dulux made its way onto the walls of Mitchell's Plain.

"We are proud to have been given the opportunity to add colour to Tafelsig and be able to inspire a community. That is our mission with all our community projects across the country and around the world. We hope that the community's work will continue to give hope to many young people for many years to come," says Nathalie Sweeney, Dulux Marketing Director Sub Saharan Africa.







The community members have generously volunteered their time to the project not only to paint the walls but also to design the final look of the walls using bright colours from Dulux. Painting started in November 2020 and is set to be completed by the end of quarter 1 2021.

This is not the end though, Bell and his team members have generously volunteered with business to develop a green belt in the Tafelsig area for the benefit of the community.

"Part of what we do is to create job opportunities for unemployed painters in the community. Ultimately, we hope to create Street Art Galleries all over Mitchell's Plain with a kaleidoscope of colours," ends Bell.
